

DH 1198 SANTA PAWS

Materials Needed: Non-fired snow glitter, Ed's glue.

Non-firing Opaque Stains: Shadow, White, Black, True Blue, Dubarry Rose, Gray, Hot Pink, Sap Green, Avocado, Flesh, Red Brown, Red, Sable Brown, Sky Blue, Venetian Gold.

STEP 1 — Clean greenhouse and fire to Cone 05.

STEP 2 — Basecoat cat's mice, gloves and boots with Shadow. Basecoat cat's coat with Dubarry Rose. Basecoat the clothes on the mice with True Blue and the Christmas bag with Sap Green.

STEP 3 — Drybrush cat with Gray and Drybrush White around eyes, mouth and side whiskers. Drybrush Gray on mice. Drybrush clothes on mice with True Blue and tip with White to soften colors. Paint gloves on mice with White and trim collars in White. Drybrush Dubarry Rose on cat's coat and Santa hat and tip with White to soften colors. Drybrush the Christmas bag with Avocado and tip with White to soften colors.

STEP 4 — Paint cat's belt Black and the buckle Venetian Gold. Paint toy soldier's face with Flesh and clothes with True Blue. Paint Venetian Gold on toy soldier's shoulder pads and buttons. Paint eyes Black and cheeks Red. Paint teddy bear with Red Brown and drybrush with Sable Brown. Paint eyes and nose Black. Paint ball with Hot Pink and stripe on ball True Blue. Paint train Black and Venetian Gold on wheels and lines on train.

STEP 5 — Paint cat's nose with Dubarry Rose and Black on the noses on the mice.

STEP 6 — Paint iris on eyes of cat and mice with True Blue and wash with Sky Blue.

STEP 7 — Paint White on fur of the cat's coat and cover fur with Ed's glue then sprinkle with non-firing glitter.

DH 1199 DOG WITH CHRISTMAS TREE

Ceramicchrome Non-Firing Opaque Stains: Black, White, True Blue, Dubarry Rose, Sap Green, Avocado, Mint Green, Inca Gold, Medium Brown, Charcoal Gray, Summer Blue, Gray, Sable Brown.

STEP 1 — Basecoat large dog and 2nd small dog Charcoal Gray. Basecoat vest on large dog Dubarry Rose and shoes and gloves True Blue.

STEP 2 — Basecoat tree, trunk and small dog in front Black.

STEP 3 — Basecoat last small dog Medium Brown.

STEP 4 — Drybrush large dog's fur and 2nd small dog's fur with White. Drybrush vest with Dubarry Rose. Tip brush in White with Dubarry Rose still on brush and drybrush vest again. Drybrush gloves and shoes with True Blue. Tip brush in White with True Blue still on brush and drybrush shoes and gloves again.

STEP 5 — Drybrush Gray on large dog and 2nd small dog to make patches on dog's fur.

STEP 6 — Drybrush Sable Brown on last small dog. Tip brush with White with Sable Brown still on brush and drybrush again.

STEP 7 — Drybrush tree with Sap Green. Using same brush, drybrush Avocado on tree. Drybrush Inca Gold in random areas. Highlight tree with Mint Green.

STEP 8 — Drybrush tree trunk with Red Brown and then Sable Brown.

STEP 9 — Paint noses Black and all dogs' tongues with Dubarry Rose. Paint iris with True Blue with a wash of Summer Blue.

DH 1200 SNOW BUNNIES

Materials Needed: Non-Fired Snow Glitter.

Ceramicchrome Non-Firing Opaque Stains: Black, White, Gray, True Blue, Dubarry Rose, Sky Blue, Inca Gold.

STEP 1 — Clean greenhouse. Fire to cone 05.

STEP 2 — Basecoat bunny Gray. Basecoat bunny's sweater, hat and gloves True Blue. Basecoat stripes with True Blue, Dubarry Rose, and White on snow bunny's scarf.

STEP 3 — Paint snow bunny's button eyes and nose with True Blue.

STEP 4 — Drybrush bunny White. Drybrush bunny's sweater and hat with True Blue. Tip brush in White to soften color and drybrush sweater and hat again.

STEP 5 — Paint snow bunny with non-fired snow and mix Sky Blue in snow and sprinkle with glitter.

STEP 6 — Paint bunny's iris with True Blue and wash with Sky Blue.

STEP 7 — Paint bunny's nose with Dubarry Rose. Drybrush Dubarry Rose on bunny's cheeks and inside ears.

STEP 8 — Paint White snow on base and sprinkle with glitter.

STEP 9 — Basecoat birds with Dubarry Rose and drybrush White. Paint belly with White and paint bird's iris with True Blue. Paint beaks with Inca Gold.

DH 1201 FROG CAROLERS

Materials Needed: Non-fired snow glitter.

Ceramicchrome Non-Firing Opaque Stains: Black, White, True Blue, Dubarry Rose, Gray, Charcoal Gray, Sap Green, Medium Green, Misty Green, Honey Toast, Suntan, Shadow, Glorious Gold.

STEP 1 — Basecoat frog's skin in Sap Green. Basecoat all three frogs' pants in Black. Basecoat frog's sport coat and hat with True Blue and scarf Dubarry Rose. Basecoat middle frog's coat and hat with Shadow and bow tie Dubarry Rose. Basecoat third frog's jacket with tails and top hat Dubarry Rose. Basecoat scarf True Blue and vest Gray.

STEP 2 — Drybrush frog's skin with Medium Green and Misty Green mixed together. Mix together Honey Toast and Suntan and highlight frogs.

STEP 3 — Drybrush frog with jacket and tails and top hat with Dubarry Rose. Tip with White for a soft look. Drybrush frog's scarf with True Blue and tip in White for a soft look. Paint collar on jacket and rim on hat Shadow. Paint buttons on vest Charcoal Gray.

STEP 4 — Drybrush middle frog's jacket and top hat with Gray. Drybrush pants with Shadow. Paint collar and cuffs on jacket, and trim on hat Black. Paint shirt White and White dots on bow tie. Paint belt Black with Glorious Gold on buckle.

STEP 5 — Drybrush frog with sport coat and hat True Blue and tip in White. Paint shirt White. Paint buttons Charcoal Gray. Drybrush pants with Black.

STEP 6 — Paint book White with holly on book. Make Black lines on book to look like pages.

STEP 7 — Paint tongues on frogs Dubarry Rose. Soften with a White wash.

STEP 8 — Paint iris with Sap Green and a wash of Medium Green.

STEP 9 — Put non-fired snow on bottom of piece with glitter.

DH 1202 DUCK WITH MAILBOX

Materials Needed: Maple Translucent Stain, Non-Firing Snow, Glitter.

Ceramicchrome Non-Firing Opaque Stains: Black, White, Buttermilk, Dubarry Rose, True Blue, Suntan, Shadow, Gray, Red Brown, Sable Brown, Sap Green, Artichoke, Misty Green, Red.

STEP 1 — Clean greenhouse. Fire to cone 05.

STEP 2 — Basecoat duck with Buttermilk. Basecoat duck's hat and scarf with Dubarry Rose and feet and bill with Suntan.

STEP 3 — Basecoat rest of piece with Shadow except mailbox.

STEP 4 — Basecoat mailbox with Dubarry Rose.

STEP 5 — Basecoat True Blue on both of squirrels' clothing. Basecoat envelope White and paint holly on it.

STEP 6 — Antique Maple on duck and wipe off with a dry cloth.

STEP 7 — Drybrush Buttermilk on duck (2 coats).

STEP 8 — Drybrush Dubarry Rose on duck's hat and scarf. Mix a little White on brush with Dubarry Rose still on brush to give it a soft look. Drybrush rim of duck's hat with White. Use True Blue and Dubarry Rose to paint stripes on hat and scarf. Shade duck with Sable Brown with a shader brush.

STEP 9 — Drybrush Gray on both squirrels; highlight with a little White on tip of tails.

STEP 10 — Drybrush True Blue on both squirrels' clothes using a little White on brush to give it a soft look. Paint collar White and gloves Gray on squirrel on mailbox. Paint trim on clothes White and gloves True Blue on squirrel on ground.

STEP 11 — Drybrush mail sack Red Brown, Sable Brown, and Buttermilk.

STEP 12 — Drybrush mailbox with Dubarry Rose then tip brush in White to give soft look. Trim mailbox in True Blue and paint holly on box.

STEP 13 — Drybrush tree trunk and nut that squirrel is holding with Red Brown, Sable Brown, and Buttermilk.

STEP 14 — Drybrush holly with Sap Green, Artichoke, and tip ends with Misty Green. Paint berries with Red.

STEP 15 — Paint iris with True Blue and wash with Heavenly Blue.

STEP 16 — On base of piece, use non-fired snow and sprinkle with glitter.

DH 1203 & 1204 LAMP AND POST

Materials Needed: Non-Fired Snow, Glitter, Light Kit.

Non-Firing Opaque Stains: True Blue, Dubarry Rose, White.

STEP 1 — Clean greenhouse. Fire to cone 05.

STEP 2 — Basecoat lamppost with True Blue.

STEP 3 — Drybrush lamppost with True Blue and dip your brush in White with True Blue still on brush to soften the color.

STEP 4 — Paint lines on lamp with Dubarry Rose.

STEP 5 — Paint non-fired snow on the oval shapes on lamppost and sprinkle with glitter.

STEP 6 — Paint snow on lid and base of lamppost, and sprinkle with glitter.

STEP 7 — Light lamp up with a light kit.

STEP 8 — Decorate with ribbons.

* To make lamppost pink, use Dubarry Rose instead of True Blue.
