

ANGELS FROM HEAVEN

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Airbrush, Antiquing Solvent, Matte Spray Sealer.

Colors By Doc Holliday: DH-2 Butter Cream, DH-3 True Orange, DH-4 True Red, DH-6 Lavender, DH-8 Black, DH-9 Real Brown, DH-10 Mustard, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-14 Rose, DH-15 Mystic Purple, DH-16 Flaxen Yellow, DH-18 Medium Brown, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-20 Sky Blue, DH-22 Christmas Red, DH-25 Toast, DH-26 Lexington Green, DH-29 White, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-34 Soft Brown, DH-36 Navy Blue, DH-37 Cream, DH-44 Blue Suede, DH-47 Silver, DH-49 Premier Gold, DH-5 Purple, FT2 Fingertip Gold, AT5 Soft Brown, AT2 Black Brown, AT4 Red Brown.

DH 1480 BLACK ANGEL, DH 1478 & DH 1479 ANGEL WITH CHILDREN

***NOTE:** Airbrush technique for DH 1480 Black Angel & DH 1478 & 1479 Angel with Children. Airbrush angel's gown White. Add a few drops of selected color to White in airbrush bottle and airbrush lightly in creases, around ribbon and inner folds of fabric. Add a few drops more of selected color and airbrush the same areas again; repeat process one more time, keeping the darkest color in the most shaded areas. Airbrush White along lower edge of dress and on any large folds of fabric.

DH 1481 ANGEL WITH LION & LAMB

Step 1: Airbrush gown using White and Mystic Purple. Basecoat skin with Soft Brown. Basecoat lamb White; lion Mustard, rock Light Grey, hair Butter Cream, wings Premier Gold.

Step 2: Antique skin, hair and lamb with Soft Brown. Antique rocks and lion with Red Brown. Wipe off excess stain from gown, hair and skin with antiquing solvent.

Step 3: Drybrush hair with Butter Cream; shade around face very lightly with a thin Toast wash. Drybrush wings and lamb White. Shade sections of wing feathers and around ribbons on gown with a very thin wash of Mystic Purple. Paint face, ears and legs of lamb Medium Brown. Shade these areas with Real Brown; highlight lightly with Deep Beige. Paint Rose inside ears and on nose. Paint ribbons White.

Step 4: Drybrush rocks Light Grey. Shade them with washes of Mystic Purple, Country Blue and Medium Brown. Drybrush rocks lightly with Cream.

Step 5: Apply a thin Real Brown wash on the mane & tail of lion. Drybrush these areas with Toast; lighten slightly with Mustard and drybrush highlights on mane & tail. Paint the ends of mane & tail hair with a thin Black wash. Drybrush the rest of lion with Mustard; add Cream to your brush and drybrush highlights to lion; make these lighter around face & toes. Shade around nose with a wash of Real Brown. Paint eyes Mustard; tint with Toast around edges. Paint nose, mouth and pupils Black. Paint lamb's eyes Black. Paint angel's eyes Country Blue, with Black pupils and lashes. Paint her lips Rose. Paint her cheeks with pink chalk.

DH 1480 Black Angel

Step 1: Airbrush gown using White, Ivory and a few drops of Toast for the deepest color. Basecoat book pages Flaxen Yellow; skin Medium Brown, wings Premier Gold.

Step 2: Antique skin with Black Brown, wiping off excess stain with soft cloth. Paint hair (painting in curls around face and neck) and hymnal Black. Paint two bands on bottom of gown and neckline Premier Gold. Shade center of hymnal and outer pages with a thin Toast wash. Also shade around lace and neckline on gown with a thin Toast wash. Drybrush lace and wings White. Shade between feather sections on wings with a thin Toast wash. Paint "words" in hymnal with Black. Paint her lips and mouth with Leather Brown; apply a wash of True Red inside mouth. Paint her eyes with Medium Brown iris' and Black pupils and lashes. Blush cheeks with Rust-colored chalk.

DH 1478 & DH 1479 ANGEL WITH CHILDREN

Step 1: Airbrush angel's gown using White and Blue Suede. Airbrush boy's pajamas using White & Country Blue; girl's gown using White & Rose and baby's gown using White & Sky Blue. Basecoat angel and boy's skin Soft Brown; girl's skin Flaxen Yellow; baby's skin Medium Brown; wings & halo Premier Gold; boy's slippers White; angel's hair Toast; boy's hair Butter Cream.

Step 2: Antique boy's, angel's and girl's skin Soft Brown. Antique baby's skin & hair Black Brown. Apply a wash of Real Brown to angel's hair. Drybrush her hair with Toast, highlighted lightly with Mustard. Drybrush boy's hair Butter Cream. Paint girl's and baby's Black. Shade around ribbon on angel's gown with Blue Suede. Shade around ruffles and neckline on little girl's gown with Rose. Shade soles of boy's slippers with a Country Blue wash. Drybrush wings White. Shade between sections of feathers with a thin wash of Suede Blue.

Step 3: Paint boy's & angel's eyes with Country Blue irises, baby's & girl's with Medium Brown irises; all have Black pupils and lashes and cheeks blushed with chalk.

DH 1474 ARCHANGEL MICHAEL (NO WINGS)

Step 1: Basecoat skin Soft Brown; rocks Light Grey; hair Butter Cream; gown Cream, antique these areas with Soft Brown.

Step 2: Basecoat leather skirt, sleeves, sword handle, & sandals Leather Brown; robe Lexington Green; front of sandals, vest & sword Silver. Apply a Black wash to these areas, shading the folds & creases of fabric & leather, allowing the Black to flow into design on vest. Drybrush robe Lexington Green, lightened with a little White. Drybrush rocks Light Grey. Apply washes of Country Blue, Toast & Black to rocks. Lightly drybrush rocks with Cream to highlight. Drybrush hair Butter Cream. Paint cross on robe and rivets on vest Gold. Paint lips with a thin wash of Leather Brown. Paint eyes with Country Blue irises and Black lashes. Paint eyebrows Medium Brown. Blush cheeks with chalk.

DH 1474 ARCHANGEL MICHAEL, DH 1475 ARCHANGEL GABRIEL & DH 1476 WINGS FOR BOTH

Step 1: Airbrush Gabriel's & Michael's gowns using White and Medium Brown. Airbrush Michael's skirt and sleeves using White and Real Brown. Paint skin Soft Brown. Paint hair Toast. Antique skin with Soft Brown. Paint Michael's vest, sword & wings Premier Gold. Paint Gabriel's trumpet & wings Premier Gold. Paint Michael's robe Christmas Red; his sandals Leather Brown with Premier Gold centers. Paint Gabriel's robe Country Blue. Paint the lower trim section of robe Navy Blue.

Step 2: Shade Michael's vest & robe with a Black wash. Drybrush his robe with Christmas Red; add True Orange to your brush and drybrush highlights to folds of robe. Paint rocks as described for Michael (without wings).

Step 3: Drybrush wings White. Shade wing sections of Michael's wings with a Toast wash. Shade Gabriel's wings with a Country Blue wash. Paint trim on Gabriel's gown Premier Gold. Apply Fingertip Gold to Gabriel's robe to bring out the brocade pattern and pattern on robe edges. Apply a wash of Real Brown to hair. Drybrush hair with Toast, lightened with a little Mustard. Paint eyes with Medium Brown irises, Black pupils and lashes. Paint lips with a thin Leather Brown wash. Paint eyebrows Real Brown. Blush cheeks lightly with chalk.

DH 1477 WREATH ANGEL

Step 1: Clean greenware carefully and fire to Cone 05.

Step 2: Basecoat face, hands and foot with Soft Brown. Basecoat hair with Flaxen Yellow. Antique these areas with Soft Brown antiquing translucent. Wipe back with soft cloth.

Step 3: Basecoat dress with White. Apply a Rose wash to entire dress. Drybrush dress again with White.

Step 4: Drybrush hair with Flaxen Yellow lightened with a little Cream.

Step 5: Basecoat wings, halo & straps on dress with Premier Gold. Drybrush wings & halo White. Shade wings with a Rose wash.

Step 6: Lips are painted Rose, lightened with a little White. Eyes are Country Blue with Black pupils. Spray with Porcelain Spray.

DH 1502 & DH 1503 ORNAMENTAL ANGEL HEADS

Step 1: While greenware is damp, make 2 small holes in back of head to insert wire to hang. Clean greenware carefully & fire to Cone 05.

Step 2: Basecoat skin with Soft Brown. Basecoat dress top with Cream and basecoat angel's hair that's down with Flaxen Yellow.

Step 3: Antique basecoated areas with Soft Brown Antiquing Translucent. Wipe back with soft cloth.

Step 4: Basecoat angel's hair that's up with Toast. Apply a Real Brown wash

TECHNIQUE SHEET 156

to hair and drybrush again with Toast. Drybrush angel's hair that's down with Flaxen Yellow lightened with Cream.

Step 5: Basecoat wings with Premier Gold and drybrush White. Shade each wing section with a Rose wash. Apply Rose to lips. Eyes are Country Blue with Black pupils.

DH 1482 ANGEL WITH PRAYING HANDS & DH 1482 ANGEL WITH HANDS OUT

Doc Holliday Colors Listed & Additional Underglazes & Glazes by Ceramichrome: #146 Pink, Pink, #104 Ruby Red, Clear Glaze, Liquid Bright Gold Glaze & Mother of Pearl Glaze.

Step 1: Clean greenware. Paint 2-3 coats of Pink, Pink underglaze to greenware, angel arms out. Fire to Cone 03.

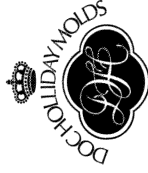
Step 2: Antique angel with arms out with Ruby Red underglaze. Paint ruby red underglaze all over dress; let dry and wipe off with a sponge. Apply 2 coats of Clear Glaze to wings, dress, band on dresses and halo. Fire to Cone 05.

Step 3: Use Liquid Bright Gold on wings, halo and bands. Use Mother-of-Pearl on pink dress. Fire to Cone 018.

Step 4: Scrub wings with ultra fine steel wool.
Step 5: Basecoat skin with Soft Brown. Basecoat hair with Flaxen Yellow. Antique with Soft Brown. Drybrush hair with Cream.

Step 6: Airbrush 2 parts True Red to 1 part Purple on dress. Add 2 drops of Black to color you airbrushed dress and shade areas on dress.

Step 7: Paint eyelashes Black, eyebrows Medium Brown and put a wash of Rose on lips. Blush cheeks with Soft Pink.
