TECHNIQUE SHEET 177

MATERIALS NEEDED: Greenware, brushes: 3/4" - 1" Flat Square Shader for Background effect, 1/2" Shader, Detail, Liner, Matte Spray Sealer.

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-10 Mustard, DH-08 Black, DH-09 Real Brown, DH-37 Cream, DH-22 Christmas Red, DH-23 Bone, DH-14 Rose, DH-25 Toast, DH-29 White, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-24 Terra Cotta, DH-34 Soft Brown, DH-43 Teal, DH-16 Faxon Yellow, DH-44 Blue Suede, DH-42 Light Grey, DH-50 Regal Purple, DH-18 Medium Brown, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-49 Premier Gold, DH-04 True Red, DH-03 True Orange, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-21 Sand

* For Cox Bottom finish same as chosen lid.

DH-1694 - COUGAR LID

Step 1: Basecoat lid (except cougar with Leather Brown)
Step 2: "Pounce n' Blend" lid with a mixture of Leather Brown and Mustard
Step 3: Basecoat cougar Black
Step 4: Wet-brush cougar with Real Brown. Repeat with Toast, then Mustard for highlights. Wet-brush markings with Cream.
Step 5: Wet-brush mouth with Christmas Red. Add a little Cream to same brush and highlight mouth.
Step 6: Paint teeth Bone. Paint nose Rose. Paint eyes Mustard. Shade eyes and teeth with a wash of Toast.
Step 7: Shade where Cream areas meet darker areas with a Toast wash. Shade cougar with a Black wash. Paint pupils Black. Line around eyes and bottom edges of teeth with Black.
Step 8: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1695 - CHEETAH LID

Step 1: Basecoat background of lid Leather Brown.
Step 2: "Pounce n' Blend" background with a mixture of Leather Brown and Black. Paint "veins" in background with Premier Gold. Paint a thin Black line next to Gold line to shade it.
Step 3: Basecoat Cheetah Black.
Step 4: Wet-brush Cheetah Real Brown. Wet-brush golden parts of Cheetah with Mustard; highlight with Faxon Yellow. Wet-brush chest, neck, muzzle, ears and above eyes with Cream. Blend where Mustard meets Cream with a wash of Mustard. Tint the fur slightly with a Toast wash. Shade muscles and creases in fur and around ears with a Black wash. Paint nose and spots on Cheetah with Black. Paint eyes Mustard, shade them with a wash of Terra Cotta. Paint pupil and outline eye with Black.
Step 5: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1692 - LION LID

Step 1: Basecoat the lid (except Lion) with Mustard.
Step 2: "Smack-dab" the lid with a mixture of Mustard and Leather Brown.
Step 3: Basecoat the Lion with Black.
Step 4: Wet-brush the Lion with Real Brown, followed by Toast. Lightly wet-brush highlights on the fur with Mustard.
Step 5: Wet-brush the muzzle, around eyes and edges of some of the mane with Soft Brown. Add Cream to same brush and highlight these areas further.
Step 6: Paint the eye Mustard. Paint the nose Leather Brown. Shade around the eye and nose areas of the fur with Real Brown and very lightly with a Leather Brown wash. Shade recessed areas of fur with a Black wash.
Step 7: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1696 - LYNX OR BOB CAT LID

Step 1: Basecoat lid (except Lynx) Blue Suede.
Step 2: "Pounce n' Blend" lid with mixture of Teal and Faxon Yellow.
Step 3: Basecoat Lynx with Real Brown. With color still in your brush, add Medium Brown and wet-brush Lynx again. Add a small amount of Cream to same brush and wet-brush highlights on the fur. Wet-brush the fur around neck, muzzle, ears and around eyes with Cream. Shade the Cream gradually out from the darker color with washes of Medium Brown and Black. Shade the indentations in fur with a Black wash.
Step 4: Paint eyes Mustard. Tint them with a wash of Grass Green; shade around them with black; paint pupils Black with White highlight.
Step 5: Paint nose Rose; shade around it with a Leather Brown wash. Paint tufts on ears with Black.
Step 6: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1693 - TIGER LID

Step 1: Basecoat lid (except Tiger) with Dark Grey.
Step 2: "Pounce n' Blend" the lid with a mixture of Regal Purple, Dark

Grey and Light Grey.
Step 3: Basecoat Tiger Black.
Step 4: Wet-brush the dark parts of fur with Real Brown; with color still in your brush, add Terra Cotta and wet-brush fur again. Add Mustard to same brush and lightly highlight the fur. Wet-brush around eyes, muzzle, ears and neck fur with White. Shade where dark fur and White meet with a wash of Terra Cotta. Shade the deeper indentations in fur and around the eyes of the upper nose with a thin Leather Brown wash. Paint the nose Rose; shade it with a Leather Brown wash. Shade the indentations in the fur with a Black wash.
Step 5: Paint the eyes Mustard; tint them with a Terra Cotta wash. Paint Black pupils. Paint legged Black stripes in Tiger's fur.
Step 6: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1743 - FISHING SPORTS PICTURE FRAME

MATERIALS NEEDED: Greenware, Various Brushes, Cleaning Tools, Matte Spray Sealer.
DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH-29 White, DH-08 Black, DH-25 Toast, DH-16 Faxon Yellow, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-10 Mustard, DH-47 Silver, DH-04 True Red, DH-37 Cream, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-20 Sky Blue, DH-30 Country Blue.
Step 1: Clean greenware and fire to Cone 03.
Step 2: Basecoat frame Black.
Step 3: Drybrush frame with Toast and highlight with Faxon Yellow. Shade picture frame Black.
Step 4: Paint fish White and paint Grass Green on tip of fish and fins. Drybrush Mustard over Grass Green and shade with Black.
Step 5: Paint bucket with Silver and water Country Blue. Paint Red stripes on bucket.
Step 6: Paint netting (refer to photo) Cream and floats on netting True Red.
Step 7: Paint fishing poles Leather Brown, Faxon Yellow. True Red and White. Paint box Leather Brown and highlight with Toast. Paint string with White.
Step 8: Paint water Sky Blue and grass, Grass Green.
Step 9: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1738 - TROUT

MATERIALS NEEDED: Greenware, Various Brushes, Super Gloss Spray, Cleaning Tools.
DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH-29 White, DH-08 Black, DH-10 Mustard, DH-25 Toast, DH-41 Willow Green, DH-45 Shadow Green, DH-14 Rose, DH-20 Sky Blue, DH-09 Real Brown, DH-04 True Red, DH-43 Teal, DH-37 Cream, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-00 Terra Cotta.
Step 1: Clean greenware and fire to Cone 03.
Step 2: Basecoat trout White and rest Black. Paint a wash of Willow Green on top, sides and fins. Paint wash of Shadow Green on top of trout and fins. Shade fins with Shadow Green. Paint a wash of Rose on gills and sides of trout. With a #1 brush paint black dots on trout. (Refer to photo for placement of dots.) Paint eyes Sky Blue with Black pupil.
Step 3: Drybrush rocks Real Brown and put washes of Mustard, Toast, Country Blue and Teal. Drybrush Cream on rocks. Shade rocks with Mustard.
Step 4: Drybrush weeds Leather Brown with heavy washes of True Red and Mustard. Shade with Black.
Step 5: Spray with Super Gloss.

DH-964 - FISH STEIN

MATERIALS NEEDED: Greenware, Cleaning Tools, Various Brushes, Clear Gloss Glaze, Glossy Black Glaze, Liquid Bright Gold, Mask-It, Airbrush, Matte Spray Sealer.
DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH-43 Teal, DH-37 Cream, DH-29 White, DH-08 Black, DH-10 Mustard, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-09 Real Brown, DH-18 Medium Blue, H-11 Beige, DH-24 Terra Cotta, DH-28 Rust, DH-27 Midnight Grey, H-11 Beige, DH-24 Terra Cotta, DH-28 Rust, DH-13 Petal Pink, DH-16 Faxon Yellow, DH-47 Silver.
Step 1: Clean greenware carefully. Fire with lid on to cone 03.
Step 2: Pour glaze inside of stein and lid with Glossy Black Glaze. Apply 3 coats of Glossy Black Glaze to inside rim of lid. Apply 2 coats of Clear Glaze to the bands on the stein and lid. Fire to cone 05.
Step 3: Paint a coat of Liquid Bright Gold to bands on stein and lid. Fire to cone 018.
Step 4: In the cup of an airbrush mix 2/3 water to 1/3 Cream. To this, add 4-5 drops of Teal and mix well. You should achieve a very pale mint green color. Use this mixture to basecoat all of the stein and lid (except fish, wood area, plants and splashing water). (Use this on the sky and water backgrounds also.) To the mixture in your airbrush cup, add 4-5 more drops of Teal. To achieve a slightly darker mint green color. Airbrush this color on the rim of the lid, near the Gold band on the top

of the stein and the raised lines near the bottom of the stein. (Refer to photo.) To the mixture in your airbrush cup, add more Teal (and water, if necessary) to get an even darker minty green color (but much lighter than straight Teal) out of the jar). Airbrush lightly over the previous areas air-brushed and solidly airbrush the bottom of the stein.
Step 5: Carefully clean the paint off the Gold bands with a sponge and water.

Step 6: The clouds: Using a "weel-worm" 1/2" shader, using circular strokes, black in the clouds with a thin wash of Cream. Using washes of Teal, Cream, White and Midnight Blue, gradually build up the clouds using circular, light, scrubbing type strokes with your brush. This will take several coats of the various colors. To highlight the clouds, add just a hint of Petal Pink and Mustard washes.
Step 7: Basecoat all the splashing water Teal. Drybrush the waves with increasingly lighter shades of Teal mixed with White. Shade the deepest parts of the water with a thin wash of Midnight Blue. Highlight the splash-ers of waves with very thin washes of Petal Pink and Faxon Yellow.
Step 8: Wet brush Teal, using long, horizontal strokes, "streak in" the water on the underwater scene side of the stein. Add a little White, Grass Green, Medium Brown (closest to the bottom) to the Teal and continue to streak the water with these colors until you get an underwater look. Randomly put in some rocks with Medium Brown. Shade the rocks with Real Brown, Cream and Black. Work on all the water area with thinned down washes, not straight color from the jar.
Step 9: Basecoat all remaining areas Black. Thin the Black to a medium wash. Use this to block in the grasses growing vertically in the water. Add extra vertical grasses if desired, around the rocks.
Step 10: Drybrush all of the Black areas with Real Brown. Get good coverage, but be sure to leave the Black showing in the crevices (be careful to let the fish scales show through).
Step 11: Drybrush the barkless areas of the tree stumps and handle with Beige. Shade these areas with washes of Medium Brown, Real Brown, and Black. Highlight the tops of stumps lightly with Cream. Lightly apply a wash of Leather Brown to the bark areas of the trees and stumps. Highlight with Toast and lightly with Mustard and Toast mixed. Half-load a 1/2" shader with a Black wash and shade the crevices of the branches and between bark and barkless areas of branches.
Step 12: Drybrush water plants and plants growing around the tree stump with Grass Green. Highlight by drybrushing with Mustard, Butter Cream, Terra Cotta and Cream. Use washes of the lighter colors near the edges of the plants and washes of Teal and Midnight Blue mixed in the centers. Shade the plants with a Black wash near their stem ends. Using vertical strokes, paint in the tall grasses in the water with Teal. Go over this with Grass Green, Mustard and Butter Cream to make the grasses show up against the water.
Step 13: Paint the top of the lure Mustard. Paint the bottom Terra Cotta. Separate the colors with a Black line. Paint a Black eye and tail and small scallops over the Mustard. Paint Silver hooks on the bottom of the lure and shade with a Black line. Paint the end of the tail White. Paint the fish line White. Paint a thin Black line on the right side of the fish line.

Step 14: Drybrush the top halves of the fish Grass Green. Highlight by mixing Mustard and Grass Green; drybrush over the Grass Green. Drybrush the bottom halves of the fish Cream. Make washes of Real Brown, Black and Rust. Use these to shade the fishes' body. (Refer to photo.) Highlight the lips of tail and fins, around the mouth and gills with Cream. Shade the bottoms of the tail and fins with Black. Paint the eyes Mustard. Paint Black pupils and outline the eyes.
Step 15: Paint the bug's wings Mustard with Terra Cotta and Black towards the centers. Paint the body Grass Green with a Terra Cotta wash over it.
Step 16: Apply 2 coats of Mask-It. Let dry. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-It.

DH-1703 - ILLUMINATION BASE, DH-1753 - FISH FOREGROUND, DH-1754 BACKGROUND.

MATERIALS NEEDED: Greenware, Various Brushes, Airbrush, Cleaning Tools, Matte Spray Sealer, Clip n' Light Kit.
DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH-08 Black, DH-29 White, DH-43 Teal, DH-44 Blue Suede, DH-09 Real Brown, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-16 Medium Brown, DH-16 Faxon Yellow, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-14 Rose, DH-25 Toast, DH-27 Midnight Grey.
Step 1: Clean greenware carefully and fire to cone 03.
Step 2: Airbrush inside and outside of base, background and foreground with Blue Suede. Shade outside of base and front of the foreground by airbrushing with Teal.
Step 3: To make the background have a underwater look, use Teal wash and make long horizontal strokes. Add White, Grass Green and Medium Brown to the Teal and continue to streak the water with these colors until you get an underwater look.
Step 4: Basecoat the water on foreground with Teal. Add White streaks to water and then shade water with Midnight Blue.
Step 5: Basecoat all remaining areas on background with Real Brown. Wet-brush all Black areas with Real Brown. Highlight log with Medium Brown and then Toast. Shade log with Leather Brown.

DH-1736 - BASS FIGURINE

MATERIALS NEEDED: Airbrush, Assorted Brushes, Matte Spray Sealer.
DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH-08 Black, DH-29 White, DH-14 Rose, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-45 Shadow Green, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-25 Toast, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-10 Mustard, DH-22 Christmas Red, DH-09 Real Brown.

Step 1: Airbrush fish White. Airbrush upper half of fish with Grass Green; highlight lighter areas with Mustard. Darken fins, upper back, around face and along sides with Shadow Green. Darken a little more with Black. Airbrush shading around gills and inside mouth with Rose.
Step 2: Shade gills with a wash of Christmas Red. Paint eyes Mustard; shade with Toast. Paint Black pupils and White highlights.
Step 3: Basecoat all remaining areas Black.
Step 4: Wet brush rocks with Light Grey. Shade and tint them with washes of Toast, Leather Brown, Country Blue and Black. Lightly wet brush the rocks again with Cream.
Step 5: Wet brush plants with Real Brown. Wet brush them again with Grass Green. Shade and tint the different types of plants with washes of Rose and Leather Brown. Highlight the rims of the leaves on washes of Willow Green wash.
Step 6: Shade plants and rocks and around fish with a Black wash. Use a line with black to define detail around plants.
Step 7: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1737 - PIKE FIGURINE

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH-08 Black, DH-29 White, DH-44 Blue Suede, DH-45 Shadow Green, DH-27 Midnight Blue, DH-10 Mustard, DH-25 Toast, DH-37 Cream, DH-23 Bone, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-09 Real Brown, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-16 Faxon Yellow.

Step 1: Airbrush fish White. Airbrush upper body with Blue Suede. Airbrush again with Shadow Green, letting some of the Blue Suede show through. Airbrush darkest areas with Midnight Blue, followed with Black.
Step 2: Paint eyes Mustard, shade them with a Toast wash. Paint pupils Black with a White highlight. Paint spots on fish with Cream. Paint Black markings on tail and fins.
Step 3: Basecoat all remaining areas Black.
Step 4: Wet brush rocks with Bone. Shade and tint them with washes of Toast, Leather Brown and Mustard. Lightly wet brush them again with Cream.
Step 5: Wet brush grasses and cattails with Real Brown. Wet brush grasses with Dark Green; highlight them with Mustard, then Faxon Yellow. Wet brush darker leaves with Shadow Green, lightened with a little White. Wet brush cattails with Toast. Shade various parts of grasses and plants with a Leather Brown wash. Shade piece with a Black wash where necessary to bring out the detail.
Step 6: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1690 - DECANTER & LID & DH-1742 BASS INSERT

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH-08 Black, DH-29 White, DH-43 Teal, DH-27 Midnight Blue, DH-37 Cream, DH-45 Shadow Green, DH-16 Medium Brown, DH-25 Toast, DH-41 Willow Green, DH-44 Blue Suede, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-47 Silver, DH-10 Mustard, SP-02 Mask-It, DH-38 Grass Green.

Step 1: Basecoat background of fish and decanter with Teal. "Pounce n' Blend" these areas with a mixture of Teal, Midnight Blue and Cream.
Step 2: Basecoat all fish area detail with White.
Step 3: Paint upper body of fish with a wash of Grass Green. Shade with a Shadow Green wash, followed by a Black wash. Shade log with washes of Medium Brown, Toast and Cream. Shade stones with washes of Blue, Teal and Teal. Shade grasses with washes of Willow Green, Blue Suede, Teal and Shadow Green. Shade plants with washes of Toast and Leather Brown. Paint top of lure Silver; paint Christmas Red near the lure. Paint eye Mustard; shade with Toast, then a Black pupil. Lightly shade with a Black wash where necessary to define and bring out detail areas.
Step 4: Fired-On Gold is used on circular trim and top rim of decanter. Protect these areas with Mask-It before spraying. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.
