

DH2482 LARGE DRIFTWOOD ELEPHANT

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: B7-3/4" shader, B6-1/2 shader, B3-round, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH12 Leather Brown, DH21 Sand, DH23 Bone, DH25 Toast, DH37 Cream, SP08 Matte Spray sealer

STEP 1: Basecoat entire piece except tusks, Black. Basecoat tusks Bone.
STEP 2: Wetbrush elephant with Dark Grey. With color still in your brush, add Cream to lighten gray color and wetbrush highlights on elephant. Tint inside ears with a very thin wash of Rose. Shade deeper crevices with a Black wash. Paint eyes Real Brown with Black pupils. Float a wash of Toast near base of each tusk. Repeat with a wash of Black.
STEP 3: Wetbrush all wood with Real Brown. Wetbrush again with Toast. Lighten and accent various parts of wood by wetbrushing with Sand and then Cream. Tint some of the lighter areas of the wood with washes of Toast, Real Brown and Leather Brown. Shade the wood (around the bark and in the crevices) as needed with a Black wash to create depth and detail.
STEP 4: Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2477 LION PLAQUE AND DH2476 TIGER PLAQUE

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: bisque, B6-1/2" shader, B2-round detail, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH12 Leather Brown, DH23 Bone, DH25 Toast, DH30 Country Blue, SP08 Matte Spray, solvent

STEP 1: Basecoat entire top of surface of plaque with Bone.
STEP 2: Shade and tint the woodgrain areas with washes of Toast, Real Brown, Leather Brown and Black (just around edge), following the direction of the woodgrain as you apply washes.
STEP 3: Using a heavy wash of Black, paint tiger stripes, noses and eyes. Corner-load B6-1/2" shader with Black and float color around edges of animal cutouts and around prominent areas of animal (around face and mane of lion, between tiger cub and tiger, around tiger's face, etc.)
STEP 4: Antique top surface of plaque with Black translucent. Wipe away excess stain from wood grain areas with cloth dampened with solvent. Leave the animals a little dark.
STEP 5: Paint outer edge of plaque Black. Wetbrush with Real Brown. With same brush, add Toast and highlight wood. Add a little Bone to same brush and highlight more.
STEP 6: Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2472 ZEBRA PLAQUE, DH2473 LION PLAQUE, DH2474 GIRAFFE PLAQUE, DH2475 ELEPHANT PLAQUE

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: bisque, B6-1/2" shader, B3-round, B1-liner, old brush to antique with, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH10 Mustard, DH12 Leather Brown, DH23 Bone, DH25 Toast, DH34 Soft Brown, DH37 Cream, DH42 Dark Grey, AT02 Black Brown Antiquing Translucent, SP08 Matte Spray sealer

DH2482 LARGE DRIFTWOOD ELEPHANT

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: B7-3/4" shader, B6-1/2 shader, B3-round, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH12 Leather Brown, DH21 Sand, DH23 Bone, DH25 Toast, DH37 Cream, SP08 Matte Spray sealer

STEP 1: Basecoat entire piece except tusks, Black. Basecoat tusks Bone.
STEP 2: Wetbrush elephant with Dark Grey. With color still in your brush, add Cream to lighten gray color and wetbrush highlights on elephant. Tint inside ears with a very thin wash of Rose. Shade deeper crevices with a Black wash. Paint eyes Real Brown with Black pupils. Float a wash of Toast near base of each tusk. Repeat with a wash of Black.
STEP 3: Wetbrush all wood with Real Brown. Wetbrush again with Toast. Lighten and accent various parts of wood by wetbrushing with Sand and then Cream. Tint some of the lighter areas of the wood with washes of Toast, Real Brown and Leather Brown. Shade the wood (around the bark and in the crevices) as needed with a Black wash to create depth and detail.
STEP 4: Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2477 LION PLAQUE AND DH2476 TIGER PLAQUE

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: bisque, B6-1/2" shader, B2-round detail, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH12 Leather Brown, DH23 Bone, DH25 Toast, DH30 Country Blue, SP08 Matte Spray, solvent

STEP 1: Basecoat entire top of surface of plaque with Bone.
STEP 2: Shade and tint the woodgrain areas with washes of Toast, Real Brown, Leather Brown and Black (just around edge), following the direction of the woodgrain as you apply washes.
STEP 3: Using a heavy wash of Black, paint tiger stripes, noses and eyes. Corner-load B6-1/2" shader with Black and float color around edges of animal cutouts and around prominent

areas of animal (around face and mane of lion, between tiger cub and tiger, around tiger's face, etc.)
STEP 4: Antique top surface of plaque with Black translucent. Wipe away excess stain from wood grain areas with cloth dampened with solvent. Leave the animals a little dark.
STEP 5: Paint outer edge of plaque Black. Wetbrush with Real Brown. With same brush, add Toast and highlight wood. Add a little Bone to same brush and highlight more.
STEP 6: Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2472 ZEBRA PLAQUE, DH2473 LION PLAQUE, DH2474 GIRAFFE PLAQUE, DH2475 ELEPHANT PLAQUE

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: bisque, B6-1/2" shader, B3-round, B1-liner, old brush to antique with, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH10 Mustard, DH12 Leather Brown, DH23 Bone, DH25 Toast, DH34 Soft Brown, DH37 Cream, DH42 Dark Grey, AT02 Black Brown Antiquing Translucent, SP08 Matte Spray sealer

ALL PLAQUES:
STEP 1: Basecoat entire piece with Real Brown.
STEP 2: Wetbrush background with Soft Brown. With color still in your brush, add Cream and wetbrush highlights on background.
STEP 3: Shade and tint the crevices in the background with washes of Toast and Real Brown.
ZEBRA: Wetbrush "light" stripes, muzzle, and inside ears with Soft Brown. Lightly wetbrush again with Cream to highlight. Paint the "dark" stripes with a heavy wash of Black. Paint eye with Real Brown iris, Black pupil.
LION: Wetbrush all of lion, except mouth and teeth with Toast. With color still in your brush add Mustard and wetbrush fur lightly again, highlighting the fluffy areas. Add a little Cream to same brush and highlight edges of fur and muzzle slightly. Paint teeth Bone. Tint them near the gum line with washes of Toast and Real Brown. Tint some of the deeper crevices in hair, around eye, inside ear and paint nose with a Black wash. Paint eye with a Mustard iris, tinted with a wash of Toast and Black pupil.
GIRAFFE: Wetbrush entire giraffe with Toast. Add a little Cream to same brush and wetbrush highlights on muzzle and inside ears. Paint spots Real Brown again. Paint over Real Brown spots and mane with a heavy Leather Brown wash. Tint near base of mane and top of horns with a Black wash. Paint eyes with a Real Brown iris, Black pupil.
ELEPHANT: Wetbrush elephant (except tusks) lightly with Toast. Wetbrush elephant

again with Dark Grey. With color still in your brush, add a little Cream and lightly wetbrush highlights on elephant. Tint around eyes, inside ears with a Black wash. Paint tusks Bone. Tint them with washes of Toast and Black. Paint eye Black.
ALL PLAQUES: Antique with Black Brown translucent. Leave quite a lot of translucent color remaining when you wipe it back. Let dry. Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2478 MONKEY ROCK, DH2479 TIGER ROCK, DH2480 RHINOCEROS ROCK, DH2481 ZEBRA ROCK

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH10 Mustard, DH19 Light Grey, DH25 Toast, DH30 Country Blue, DH37 Cream, SP08 Matte Spray sealer

STEP 1: Basecoat rock with Black. Wetbrush Mustard, Country Blue, Toast and Real Brown with washes on rock portion only.
STEP 2: Wetbrush entire piece with Light Grey and highlight with Cream. Shade creviced areas with Black.
STEP 3: Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH1698 LION

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH10 Mustard, DH16 Flaxon Yellow, DH25 Toast, DH30 Country Blue, DH37 Cream, DH38 Grass Green, SP08 Matte Spray

STEP 1: Basecoat lion with Flaxon Yellow. Basecoat rock and leaves with Black.
STEP 2: Wetbrush Mustard on light areas of lion and paint washes of Mustard on lion's mane. Wetbrush Toast on shaded areas on lion's back and legs. Shade Toast around lion's face and mane. Wetbrush Real Brown on lion's back and shade muscle tones. Wetbrush Cream on lion's fur, under tail, under body and inside legs. Shade Cream around lion's mouth. Paint a wash of Black on lion's tail and fur around face. Shade Black on lion's nose and mouth. Paint eyes Mustard and pupils Black. Nose and mouth are Black.
STEP 3: Wetbrush rock with Cream. Paint rock with washes of Mustard, Country Blue and Toast. Let dry. Wetbrush rock with Cream and shade with Black. Paint leaves with Grass Green and highlight with Mustard.
STEP 4: Spray with Matte Spray sealer.
